## Broadcasters tune in to Games

**NEW DELHI:** The three-day World Broadcasters' Meet to assess preparations for the Commonwealth Games in Delhi next year ended here earlier this week. Rights-holding broadcasters from various Commonwealth nations took part in the meet.

The Organising Committee of the Commonwealth Games made presentations on the venues, security, accommodation, transportation and accreditation among other things. Interactive sessions were held between the presenters and rights-holding broadcasters.

SIS Live, U.K., a group engaged by the host broadcaster for production and coverage activities presented its proposed production and coverage plan for the Games.

### One-to-one sessions

On the second day of the meet, venue visits were undertaken to appraise the group on the progress being made at the various competition venues. The final day was dedicated to one-to-one interactive sessions.

Prasar Bharati CEO B.S. Lalli announced that the second World Broadcasters' Meet would be held in Delhi from April 16 to 18 next year.
